### Lower Waikato river Trout Contest Rules 2023

All contestants must have NZ Fish & Game current Licences for 2023/24 and abide by their rules regarding methods & tackle used in the Waikato region. All legal fishing methods welcome; trolling, fly fishing, spinning & bait fishing. Contest area- Waikato river only from below Karapiro dam to Waikato Heads.

Contest fishing hours; From Dawn on Thursday 12th October to 3pm Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> October. WEIGH INS-

(Huntly- day) The Meat Company, 112 Main St Huntly ph. (07) 8287540, 8am to 5.30 pm Thursday & Friday, 8am to 1 pm Saturday only.

(Hamilton- day) Waikato Hunting & Fishing, 674A Te Rapa Rd, Hamilton: ph. (07) 849 0297 9 am – 5.30 pm Thursday and Friday, 9 am - 4 pm Saturday, and also 10 am – 3 pm Sunday 15th only.

(Cambridge- day) Cambridge Hunting & Fishing, 2 Oliver St, Cambridge; ph (07) 834 3553 9am – 5 pm Thursday and Friday, 9 am to 4 pm Saturday and also 10 am – 3 pm Sunday 15th.

(Taupiri- all evenings) Taupiri Tavern, the Crescent, Taupiri: ph (07) 824 6842 7.30pm – 9.30 pm Thursday 12th to Saturday 14th , mid day to 3 pm Sunday  $15^{th}$ . Note; final weigh-in time is <u>3 pm sharp</u> on Sunday  $15^{th}$ .

All fish weighed <u>must</u> be accompanied by contestant's entry number & fishing licence, and the Judges decision is final.

Prize giving & Barbeque: Will be held at Taupiri Tavern, the Crescent, Taupiri on Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> October at 5 pm.

Every contestant is urged to attend; many spot prizes are available only for those present, (especially the \$500 draw) plus there are raffles, and a free barbeque preceding the prizegiving.

All competitors enter this competition <u>at their own risk</u> and should take all necessary precautions regarding water & personal safety. Lifejackets mandatory on boats at all times.
